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Five years in software: three as a full-time QA on apps used by roughly **80,000** people a day, then product work on a payments platform — TypeScript across React, Next.js and Node. My repositories are private; the contribution graph is not — **3,195** contributions in the last twelve months.

Payments platform with global checkout and automatic currency conversion. Two developers on the platform.

- **The largest individual contribution to the codebase** — **2,030** commits across 13 repositories, 13 consecutive months.
- Owned the merchant panel (**469** commits): products, checkout links, order bump, upsell, tracking pixels, shipping, orders, domains and financials.
- Worked inside **database/entities** (**115** commits) and **database/migrations** (**38**) of the NestJS payments API — the data model itself, in production, not adjacent to it.
- Built **EvolluteZap**, a Manifest V3 browser extension automating WhatsApp Web: **31,589** lines, 82% of the repository, TypeScript service worker, e2e test harness.
- Subscription product with **KYC** compliance (**382** commits) and a component library published as an internal package.

QA Tester — Jera Software Jul 2021 — Apr 2025 · Remote
Official mobile apps for Rock in Rio, Rock in Rio Lisboa, Lollapalooza Brasil and The Town.

- **On-call during live festivals**, with the app in production and roughly **80,000** people depending on it per day. No "we'll ship the fix tomorrow".
- The 2025 Lollapalooza cycle closed at **99.79%** stability on Android across **23** releases — figures published by the employer, not self-reported.
- Device-matrix testing on iOS and Android, pre-release and in production. Nine months as an intern, then **3** years full-time.

Web Developer — English Patio May 2025 — Aug 2026 · Remote, alongside the role above
Language school in Goiânia. Built for people close to me; the project has since closed.

- Site plus the dashboard the staff runs the school on — **50k** lines, **419** commits over 16 months, in daily use with real students. Enrollment happens in the browser: a long form writes into the school's own PDF contract, which goes out for electronic signature.
